Saimaa Archipelago route

The Saimaa Archipelago Route in the southern part of Lake Saimaa offers a spectacular scenic route for cyclists and the opportunity to explore unique cultural sites. On the 160 km route along the shores of Lake Saimaa and the pine forests of the Salpausselkä, you will see the sights of Lappeenranta, Imatra, Taipalsaari and Ruokolahti. Combine the route with the Savitaipale tour and you'll see idyllic countryside and Kärnäkoski Fortress. There are also several Saimaa UNESCO Global Geopark sites along the Saimaa Archipelago Route that are well worth a visit!



Planning your trip

Cycling routes on Lake Saimaa are mainly on paved roads, in gently undulating terrain. There are also gravel roads along the way, which are suitable for normal bicycles. For longer routes, it is advisable to set aside several days to enjoy the stunning scenery of the southern Saimaa and the local amenities.

Find out in advance about the accommodation, restaurants, and water connections along the routes so that you can plan and schedule your trip.

Equipment and safety

Cycling routes on Lake Saimaa are partly on busy roads. For your safety, please remember to wear the correct cycling equipment, such as a cycle helmet and clearly visible clothing. It is also a good idea to always carry a first aid kit with you. Be sure to bring a drink for the ride and an energy-boosting snack. Please note that there are no grocery stores between Taipalsaari and Utula. There is a possibility to buy drinks from the Cycle Ferry Rasti.



Ferries

The routes are served by cycle ferries and car ferries that take you across waterways. The car ferries are free of charge for tourists and run 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Cycle ferries run according to the timetable indicated and are subject to a charge. Tickets for the ferries must be purchased in advance at the Matkahuolto ticket office. Please note that the ticket office closes 2 hours before departure

Things to see along the route - Historic towns

Lappeenranta

Lappeenranta is an international university and tourist city whose development is guided by environmentally friendly values and actions. The harbour and the historic fortress, located close to the city centre, are at the heart of a city known for its hospitality by residents and tourists alike.

Imatra

Imatra is Finland's national treasure and for good reason - it is home to Finland's oldest tourist attraction, the Imatrankoski and its adjacent Art Nouveau castle, numerous sporting and cultural events and the Vuoksi, which brings power and pulse to the city from the flowing water. In addition, the modern sports tourism area of Ukonniemi, in the immediate vicinity of Lake Saimaa, also provides an excellent base for cycling enthusiasts.

Taipalsaari

Taipalsaari is known for its natural beauty and abundance of water bodies. Half of Taipalsaari's area is covered by the Saimaa and the other half consists of around 700 islands. Taipalsaari offers a wide range of things to do in all seasons for tourists and leisure visitors alike.

Savitaipale

Savitaipale is located on the shores of the clear-water Lake Kuolimojärvi and on top of the inner Salpausselkä. The northern edge of the ridge rises up to 40 metres in places and the landscape is uniquely varied. Savitaipale has great nature trails and destinations for outdoor activities and hiking.

Ruokolahti

Ruokolahti is a town formerly known for its lion and nowadays also for its great cycling facilities. The municipality has Finland's longest pump track, excellent cycling trails and Saimaa Bikepark. Ruokolahti's renowned Geopark sites include Kummakivi and Ruokolahti Church Hill.

Nature and recreation sites on the shores

Sarviniemi

Sarviniemi has been a traditional holiday destination on the shores of Lake Saimaa. On the site of the former holiday village, facilities for hikers have been built. Now it is a hub for cycle routes, with the Rasti ferry running to Kyläniemi and Puumala. Sarviniemi has a cosy campfire shelter and an unobstructed viewpoint at the tip of the peninsula.

Huuhanranta

Huuhanranta is listed as one of the most beautiful sandy beaches in the country and at 1.5 km long it is one of the largest in Lake Saimaa. The beach is fine sand and slowly deepening, you can wade up to 100 m from the beach. A barbecue shelter is available for cyclists stopping by during the day as well as for

Rastinniemi

Rastinniemi, located in Kyläniemi on the eastern bank of Rastinvirta, is one of the finest hiking destinations in Lake Saimaa. Rastinniemi is about 4 km from Kyläniemi harbour, 3 km of which is on a sandy road, but it's worth cycling to get there. There are two campfire shelters for self-sufficient hikers.

Summer island trips to Ilkonsaari and Ruuhonsaari

Hop aboard m/s Rasti from Sarviniemi and come enjoy the lake scenery and the great nature on the Saimaa Islands!

Islands of Ruuhonsaari

Ruha, or Ruuhonsaari, is a popular picnic harbour for boaters. The island is dotted with pine trees and you can walk around the beaches or along the ridges. Ruuhonsaari has a sandy beach, a sauna and campfire shelters for picnics.

Puumala **Archipelago route**

The Saimaa archipelago route can be combined with the Puumala archipelago route on a ferry trip. The approximately 60-kilometre-long cycle route passes through islands, bridges and ridges. In summer, the ferry takes cyclists between Lintusalo and Hurissalo. The Puumala archipelago route includes the magnificent Pistohiekka with its beach, the Lietvesi scenic road and the local food oasis Sahanlahti. Puumala's lively harbour invites you to enjoy the relaxed atmosphere and local delicacies.

Ilkonsaari - skiittasaari

A unique destination on the island of Saimaa! You can enjoy the cliffs, swim in the sandbanks and have a picnic in the campfire shelters. The specialities of Skiittasaari are five orthodox tsasounas, or chapels. The chapels along the path that runs through the island are all different, each has a counterpart in a European monastery.











